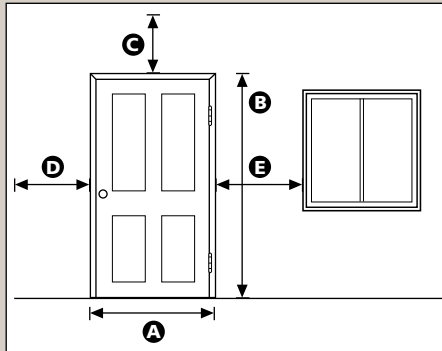


STEP 1

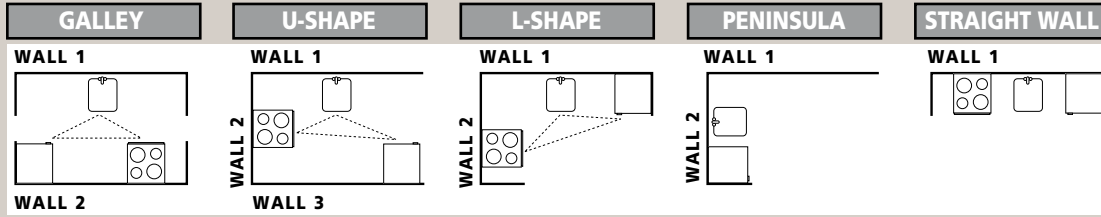

To help you with your planning, we've provided a cursory outline of the work ahead. The amount of work naturally depends on the complexity of your project.

- > Plumbing: Dismantling; closing of water supply valves to sink, dishwasher and all other appliances connected to a water supply. Relocation of plumbing if necessary and connection of various elements (sink, dishwasher and more).
- > Electricity: Dismantling; disconnection of wall oven, cooking plate, range, refrigerator, dishwasher and other appliances. Relocation of outlets for floor and countertop appliances. Provision of electricity for recessed or fluorescent lighting, installation of wires and outlets, and connection of oven and cooking plate (or range), dishwasher and range hood.
- > Removal of existing kitchen.
- > Moving and rebuilding of walls, if necessary.
- > Moving of range hood vent, if necessary.
- > Installation of gypsum board, treatment of joints, painting.

- > Floor covering (depending on the project).
- > Arrival of appliances (depending on the project).
- > Arrival of kitchen furniture (depending on the project).
- > Installation of cupboards (includes fitting of recessed appliances such as oven, refrigerator and dishwasher). Does not include installation of range hood, connections, electrical hookups and plumbing. Cooking plate and sink will be installed at the same time as countertop.
- > Type of countertop: granite, quartz, Corian or laminate. Plan on building a template, and installing countertop two to three weeks later.
- > Installation of countertop backsplash.

Renovating a kitchen takes planning. Count on four to eight weeks to complete your project, including a two- to three-week period to manufacture and install counters.
